

RECOMMENDED ATTIRE

Here are some guidelines to help you dress for the environment at the *Ching Farm Rescue & Sanctuary*. Protecting yourself by wearing proper clothing can help prevent injuries or lessen any that may occur. Year-Round



- Any brand of knit latex coated gloves. These are preferred because they're cheap, durable, and cruelty-free (as compared to leather working gloves).
 - Available on [Amazon](https://www.amazon.com), various hardware stores, or at IFA in Draper or Riverton.



- Rubber boots
 - Most commonly purchased at IFA in Draper or Riverton for ~\$14.99. Other rubber work or gardening boots would also be acceptable.
- Sunblock
- Sunglasses

- Minimal jewelry

Note: It can get caught or draw unwanted attention from animals such as emus.

Winter



- Waterproof & insulated “Snow Blower” gloves. These are ideal during winter shifts when you’ll be dumping or filling water bowls or troughs for the animals.
 - Available on [Amazon](#) or at IFA in Draper or Riverton.
- Snowboard, ski, or other waterproof pants
- Thermals
- Double up on socks
- Warm hat or beanie

Summer

- Lightweight shirts with sleeves
- Lightweight, but sturdy pants
 - Wear shorts at your own risk
- No sandals or open-toed shoes allowed
- Wide-brimmed hat
